

Deepdene Tennis Club Inc.

Alcohol Policy

23 January 2014

Introduction

The Deepdene Tennis Club holds a BYO Permit under the Liquor Control Reform Act 1998. A copy of the permit is permanently displayed inside the club rooms at 126 Whitehorse Road, Deepdene. The permit describes the conditions under which alcohol may be consumed at the club.

BYO Permit

The permit allows members and guests aged 18 years and over to consume, possess or control liquor within the designated area during the specified hours. It is illegal and an offence to sell alcohol under this permit. Any person deemed drunk or disorderly will be required to leave the premises immediately.

Designated Area

Liquor may only be consumed within the 'red line' area shown on the approved plan. A copy of this plan is permanently displayed within the club rooms. This area includes the club rooms and the courtyard area in front of the courts. It is illegal to consume or possess alcohol outside this area. At no time may alcohol be taken onto the tennis courts.

Trading Hours

The permit allows alcohol to be consumed within the designated area during the following hours only:

Sunday	Between 12 noon and 9.30 pm
Monday to Friday	Between 7 pm and 10.30 pm
Saturday	Between 12 noon and 11 pm
Public Holidays	Between 12 noon and 9.30 pm

Amenity

Under the BYO Permit, the club, including all its members and guests, must have regard to the amenity of the area. Specifically, members and guests shall not cause or permit undue detriment to the amenity of the area in connection with the use of the premises during or immediately after the approved trading hours. This includes noise, rubbish, indecent or offensive behaviour, drunkenness on the street, vandalism and nuisance behaviour.

Approvals

Persons under the age of 18 years are permitted on the premises during the permitted BYO trading hours but no later than 11 pm on any day. Under no circumstances will people under the age of 18 consume alcohol at the club.

Member Responsibility

It is the responsibility of every club member to ensure that these conditions are adhered to at all times by all members and visitors. If for any reason members or visitors are found to be in breach of any of these conditions then the Committee will take appropriate action.
